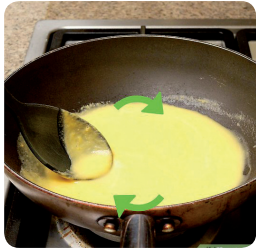


Cauliflower cheese

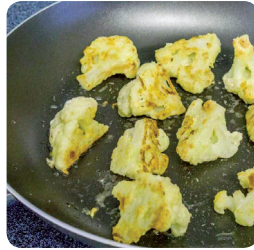
- Preheat the oven to 180°C.

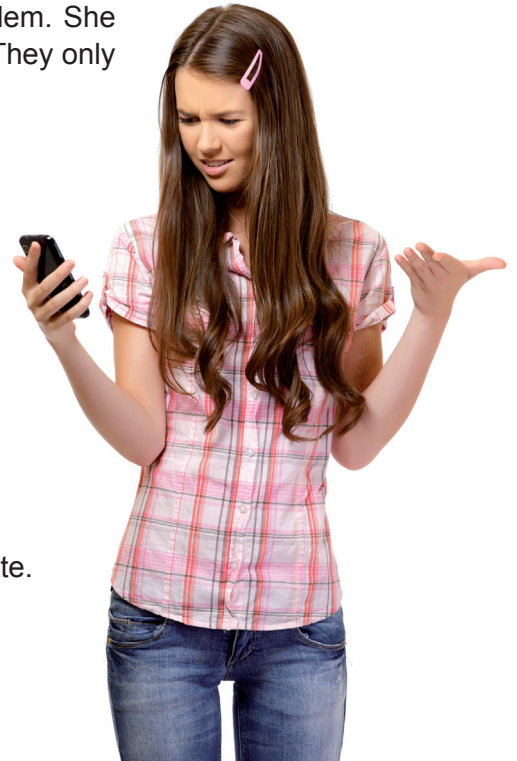

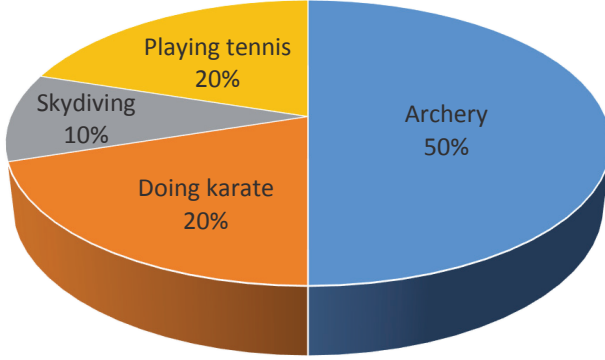
