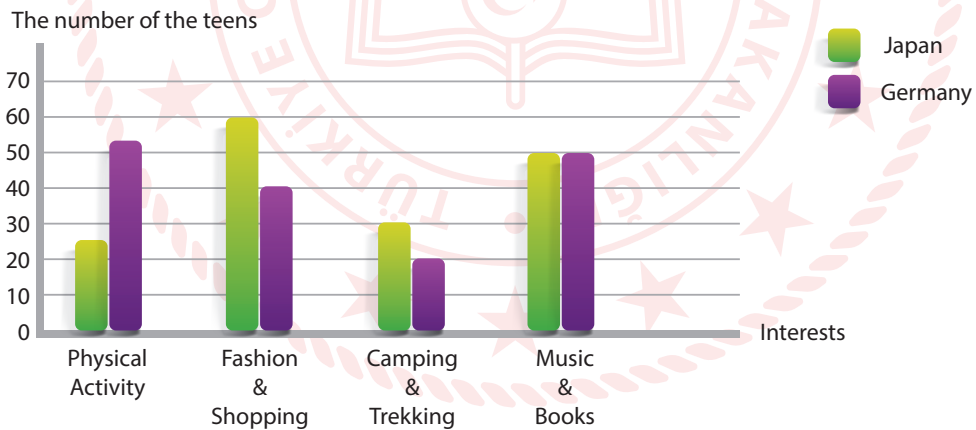

**Albert** : Both teenager groups' most favourite activity is spending time in nature.

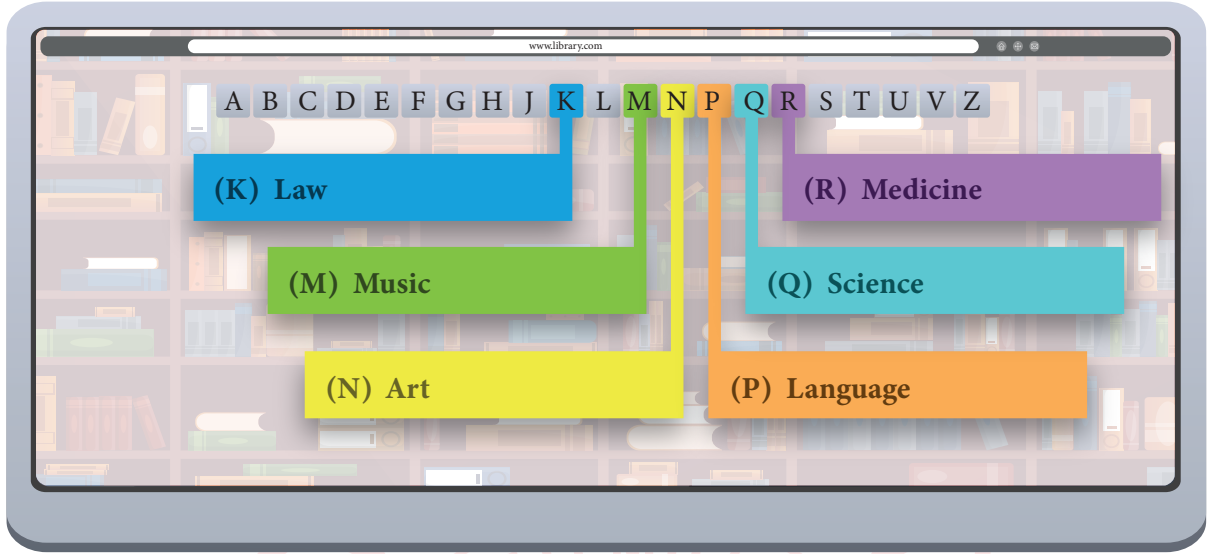
**Richard** : The number of German teenagers who like exercising is smaller than the ones who like buying things.
