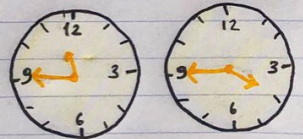
- 09:00 = It's nine o'clock.
- 04:00 = It's four o'clock.
- 22:00 = It's ten o'clock.
- 18:00 = It's six o'clock.



- 15:30 = It's half past three.
- 01:30 = It's half past one.
- 20:30 = It's half past eight.
- 11:30 = It's half past eleven.



- 06:15 = It's quarter past six.
- 10:15 = It's quarter past ten.
- 15:15 = It's quarter past three.
- 21:15 = It's quarter past nine.



- 11:45 = It's quarter to twelve.
- 03:45 = It's quarter to four.
- 20:45 = It's quarter to nine.
- 07:45 = It's quarter to eight.
