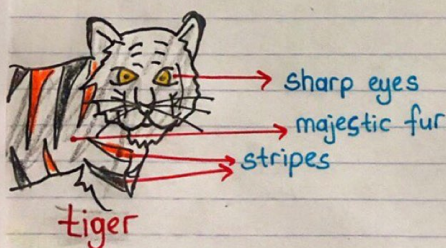
1. Animals - Body Parts - Characteristics

2. Types of Animals

REPTILES

- alligator

- They are air-breathing vertebrates.
- Scales > cover their bodies.
- Bony plates
- Cold-blooded animals = No constant body temperature
- Shedding the outer layer of skin

BIRDS

- eagle
- owl
- falcon
- parrot
- flamingo
- raven
- hawk
- seagull
- ostrich
- stork

- They lay eggs.
- Birds can fly, but penguins and ostriches can't fly.
(wing, beak, fur...)

NOTE :

- Dinosaurs are extinct animals.
- Pandas are endangered animals.

endangered = in danger of extinction
(not many — in the world)

3. What do animals eat?

- carnivore** = eating meat and other animals. (cheetah, alligator, lion...)
- herbivore** = eating grass, plants, leaves etc. (giraffe, zebra, cow...)
- omnivore** = eating meat and plants (bear, squirrel...)

4. Where do wild animals live? (HABITAT)

- desert (camel)
- forest (king of forest : lion)
- grassland (deer, zebra...)
- jungle (monkey, koala bear...)
- rain forests (snake, tiger...)
- mountain (giant panda, bear...)
- marsh (crocodile...)
- pole (penguin, polar bear...)
- ocean (shark, octopus...)
- sea (dolphin, seal...)

Amphibians can live both in water and on land.



We shouldn't put animals into cages!

We should let them live in their natural habitats!

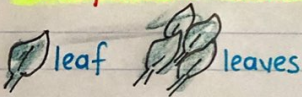


5. Reasons of Extinction
