



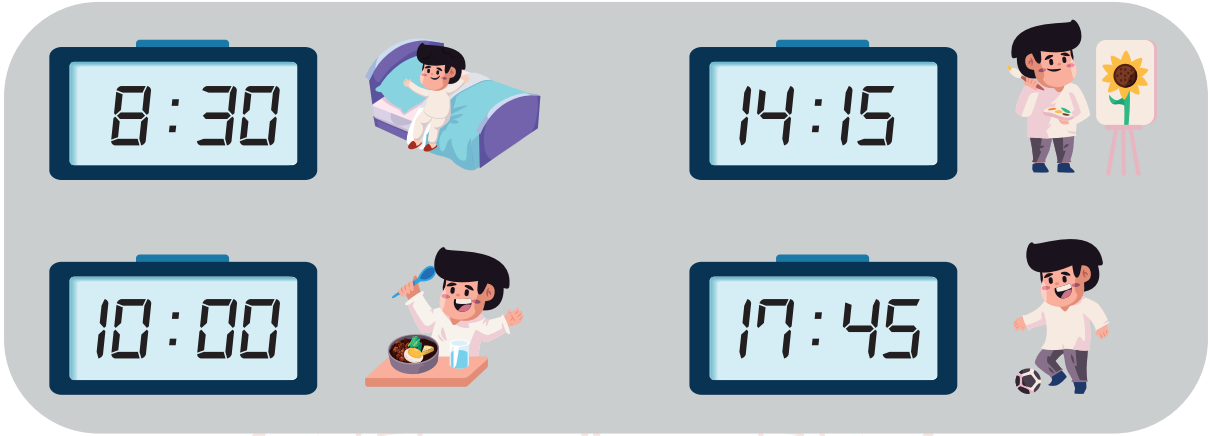

Berkay's Sunday Routines



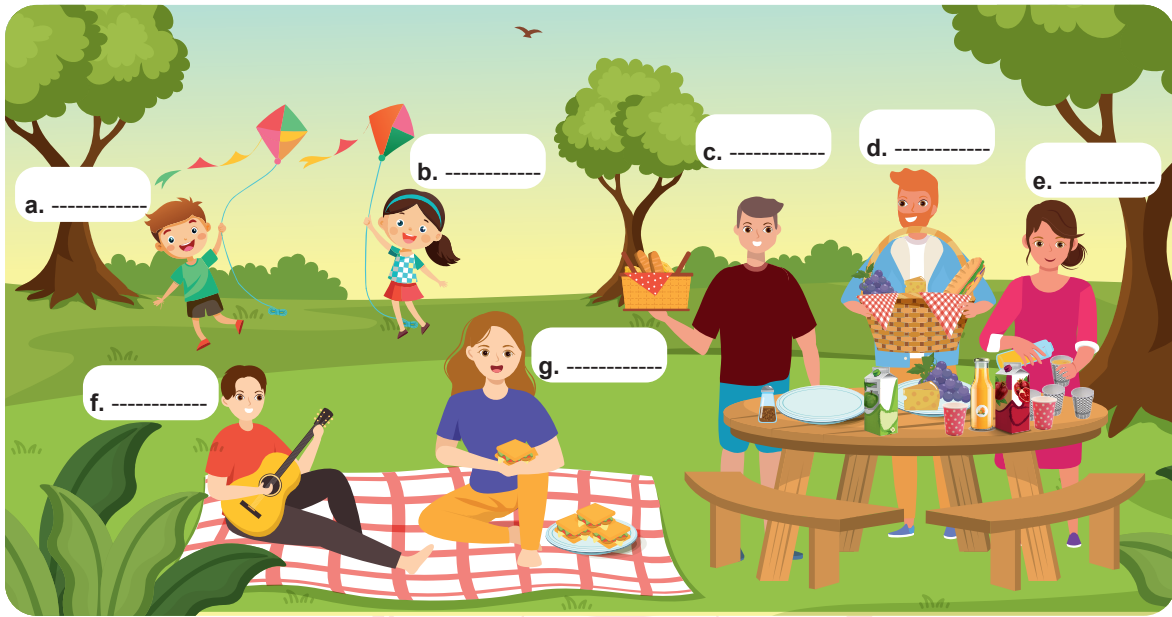
- What time does Berkay get up?

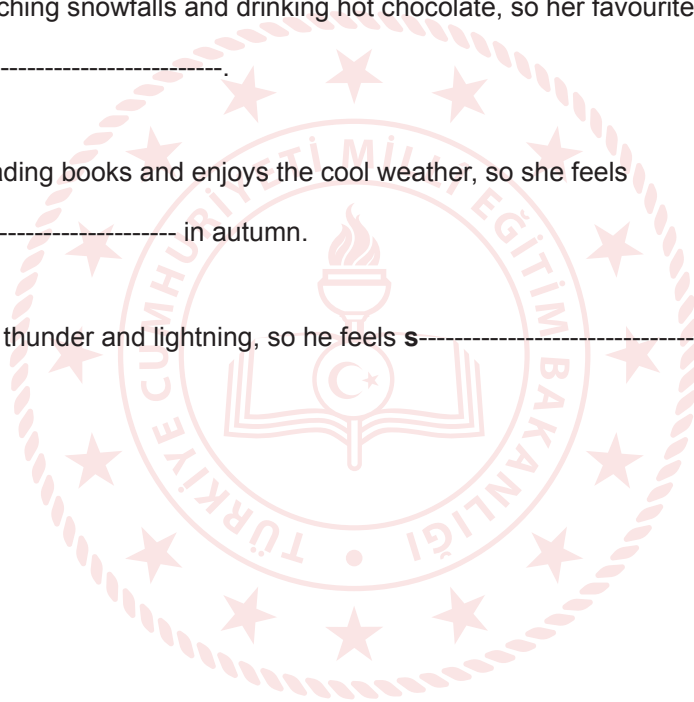
