Phil: That's a good idea. I should try it.

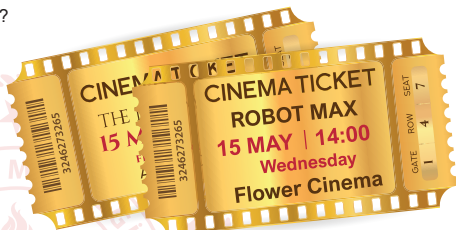

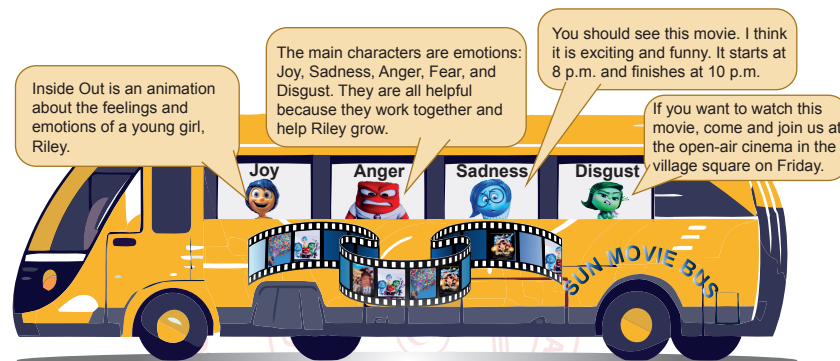
