Expressing preferences (Tercihleri ifade etme)

- Do you prefer cooking pizza or pasta?(Pizza mı makarna mı pişirmeyi tercih edersin?)
- I prefer pizza. (Pizza tercih ederim.)
- I love cooking and eating pizza. (Pizza yemeyi ve pişirmeyi severim.)
- I usually prefer cooking pasta. (Genellikle makarna pişirmeyi tercih ederim.)
- I am crazy about pasta / cooking pasta. (Makarnaya / Makarna pişirmeye bayılırım.)
- I can't stand pizza. (Pizzaya tahammül edemem.)

Making simple inquiries (Basit soru sorma)

- Do I use two or three eggs? (İki mi üç mü yumurta kullanmalıyım?)
- What can/should I use to cook soup? (Çorba pişirmek için ne kullanmalıyım?)
- How many minutes do you heat the oven? (Fırını kaç dakika ısıtırsın?)
- How much sugar do we need? (Ne kadar şeker ihtiyacımız var?)

I'm sorry to hear that. We'll meet up later, then. (Bunu duyduğuma üzöldüm. O hâlde daha sonra buluşuruz.)

I'll get back in an hour. (Bir saat içinde aramanıza döneceğim.)

[The phone rings] I will take that. (Telefon çalar; Ben bakarım.)
